This database includes information about bills initiated by the executive. Bills submitted by the executive shall have an explanatory memorandum and the necessary supporting information so as to make possible a decision on them (article 109 of the Congress' Standing Orders). The Bureau of Congress is responsible for publishing the bill and for setting a date for the opening of the period during which amendments may be proposed and refer the bill to the appropriate committee.
